Teaching Math Tips

- Present concepts step-by-step.
- Follow oral directions well, so explain things out loud!
- Present the material order from easy to complex.
- Have student repeat directions out loud after explaining.
- Progress from easy to difficult material.
- Allow them to do verbal assessment and explain concepts out loud.
